



Club Med Les Arcs Panorama won its 1st Award



Club Med Les Arcs Panorama, the new Club Med resort opened at the end of last year in the French Alps, won the Award for “Europe Hotel over 200 rooms” category at the International Hotel & Property Awards 2019 which took place in Capri on June 28, 2019.

This competition is hosted by *design et al*, a leading UK interior design magazine. It recognizes and rewards design talents in different categories covering hotel design, interior design and luxury real estate design around the world.

This award rewards the “striking architecture” of this new Club Med resort and highlights the architect's artistic choices, Christian Plateau, of the Parisian agency “Atelier Cap Architecture”, who was inspired by Charlotte Perriand, a student of *Le Corbusier*. The jury appreciated the integration of the resort into the landscape with the descending buildings, just as Les Arcs had been designed since its creation in 1968.
